- Speak English less than “very well” is a subset of ‘Language Spoken at Home’ as collected by the American Community Survey (ACS).
- Only persons 5 years and older are taken into account since the ability to speak a language is attained around that time.
- City of Houston’s percentage share is higher than Houston-Sugar Land-Baytown and the State of Texas and almost three times higher than the United States.
- The top ten languages spoken in the City of Houston are (other than English): Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese, French, Urdu, Arabic, Hindi, Tagalog (Philippines) and Korean
